If this subpoena is for documents containing any of the information enumerated below, you are to redact that information before turning over the documents. The types of information to be redacted are:

- (1) Social Security and taxpayer-identification numbers;
- (2) birth dates;
- (3) mothers' maiden names;
- (4) driver's license numbers;
- (5) financial account numbers; and
- (6) debit and credit card numbers.
