Dear Friends:

The November 2, 2010 Gubernatorial Election will be remembered for a spike in no-excuse mail-in absentee voting, a significant shift in partisan support, and some extremely close races. Due to the tight contest in the 8th Congressional District, the election ended two weeks after Election Day when all absentee and provisional ballots were tallied. If the popularity of absentee voting grows, this scenario could become more common with every election.

This post-election report will give you a snapshot of political trends in the Cook County suburbs. Please mull over the results and analysis. For example:

- More than 25,000 mail-in absentee ballots were cast, or 3.5 percent of all ballots cast – 2.5 times the number of absentee ballots cast in the 2006 gubernatorial election. This is due to the change in state law that allows anyone to request an absentee ballot.
- Early Voting turnout was also up considerably over 2006. About 86,000 early voted in this election, more than 2.5 times the early turnout of 33,000 in 2006.
- Turnout reached 53 percent, up from 50 percent in 2006.
- Nearly 70 percent of voters in New Trier township participated – the highest turnout by a township for the third consecutive gubernatorial election.
- In the 2008 presidential election, only three townships voted a majority Republican for President, the top race on the ballot. This election that number grew to 15 – half of all townships – in the U.S. Senate race, marking a significant shift in voting patterns.
- Nine townships picked all Democrats for statewide offices, but 15 townships picked Republicans for four offices: U.S. Senate, Governor, Comptroller and Treasurer.
- Incumbents won 89 of 112 federal, state and county contests, a victory rate of 79 percent.

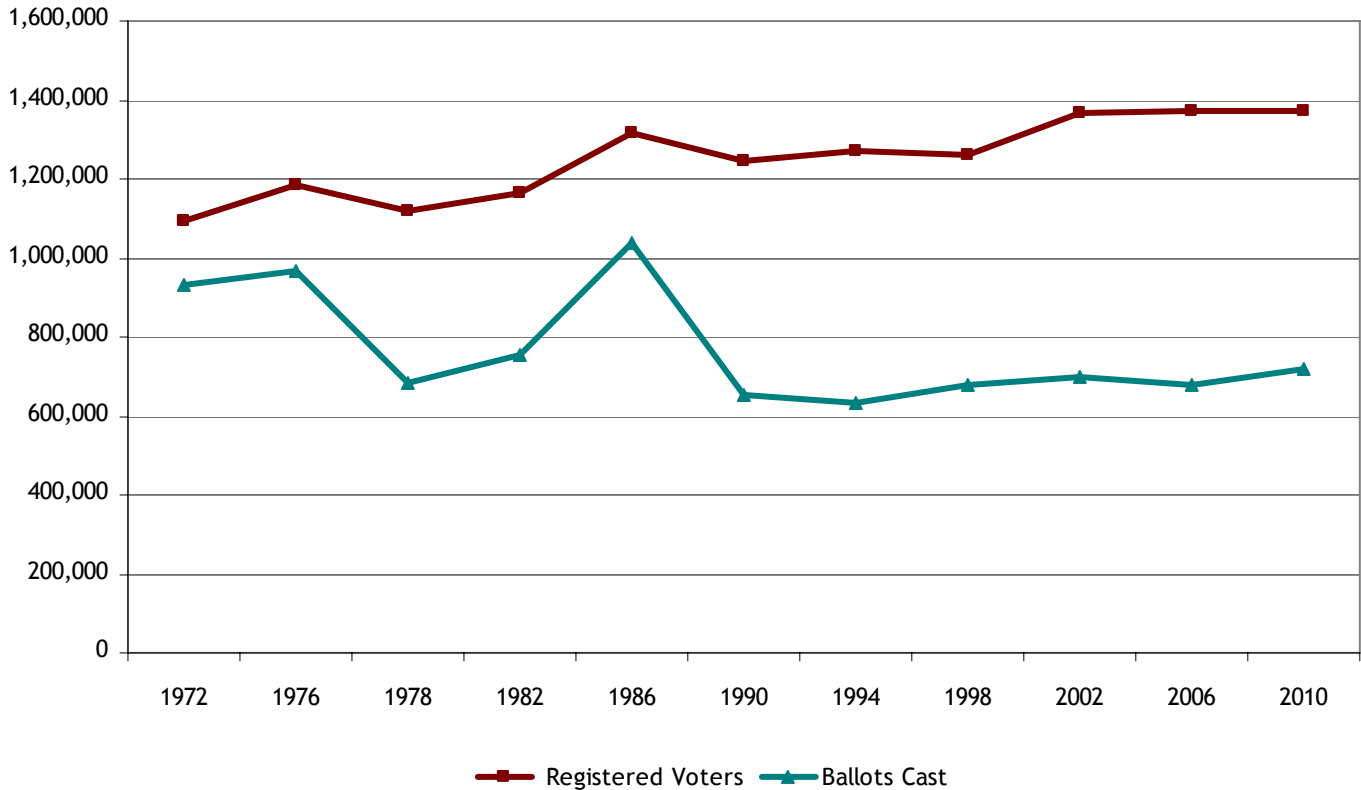
Voter turnout slightly up

While the number of registered voters remained virtually unchanged from 2006 to 2010, the number of ballots cast increased by more than 18,000. Turnout was 52.5 percent this election, holding true to a 20-year trend where gubernatorial turnout hovered near 50 percent.

Gubernatorial Election Turnout: 1972-2010



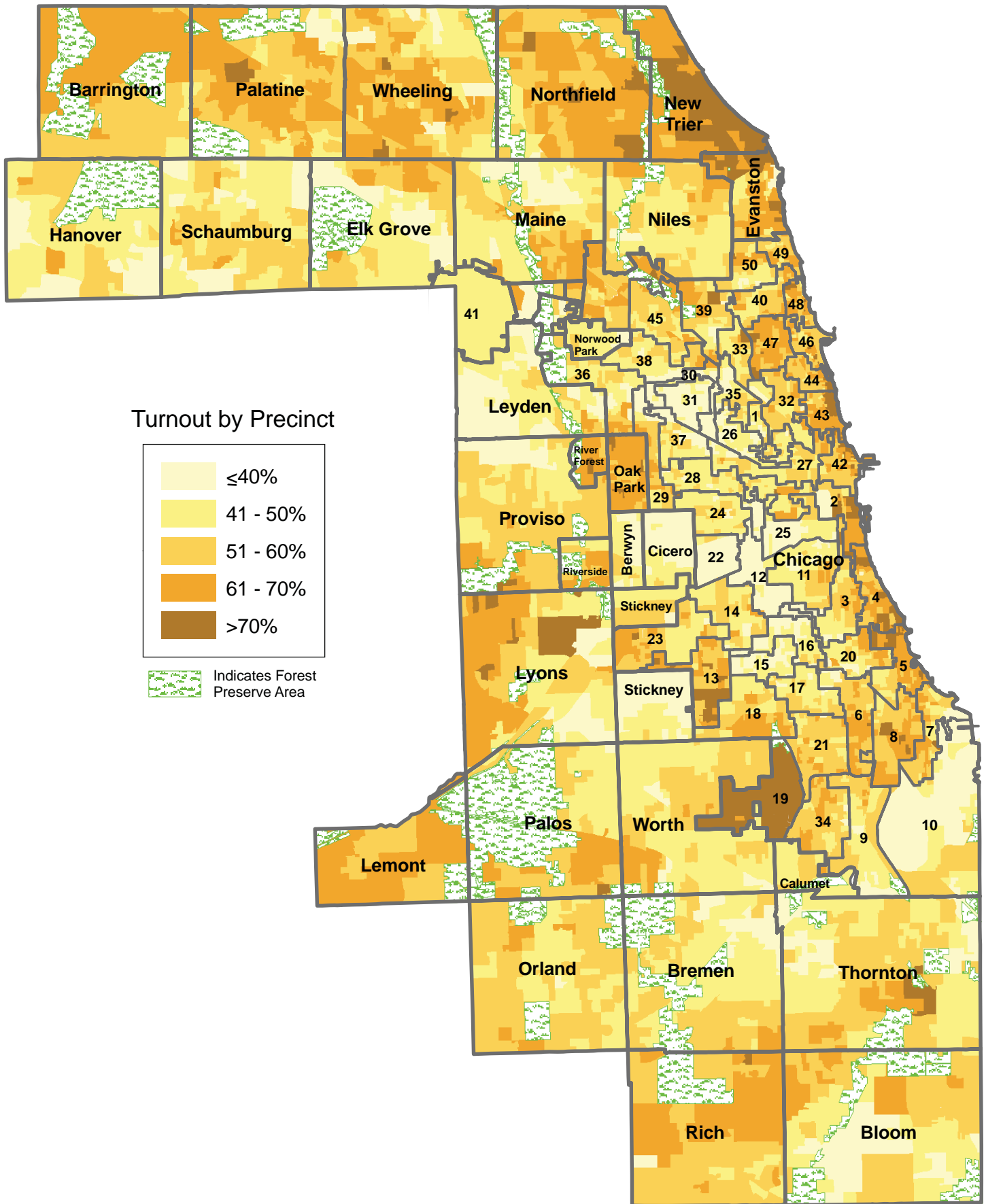
New Trier voters continue high turnout trend

Slightly more than half (52.5 percent) of all suburban Cook County voters participated in the Nov. 2, 2010 election, which is an average turnout for a midterm election. At 69.9 percent, New Trier township had the greatest percentage of voters who cast ballots, a trend for the third consecutive gubernatorial election. Turnout also topped 60 percent in River Forest (65.5 percent) Oak Park (63.2 percent) Northfield (61.7 percent) Lemont (60.5 percent) and Evanston (60.2 percent). Cicero had the lowest turnout at 34.5 percent.

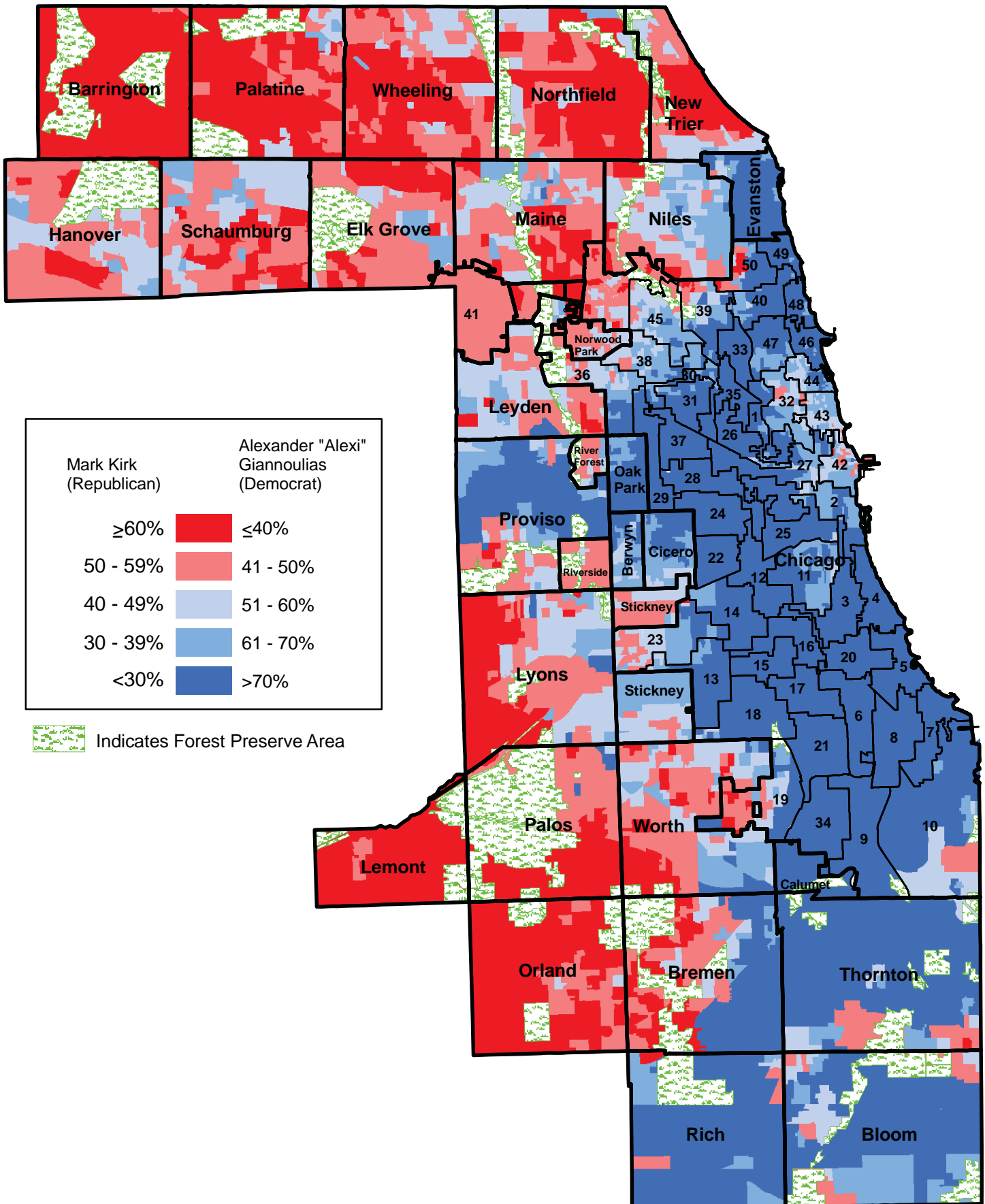
Party shift in suburban Cook by % ballots cast: 2008 vs. 2010

In the last general election in 2008, when President Obama's race was at the top of the ticket, the majority of voters cast Democratic ballots in all but three townships. In 2010, there was a drastic shift as half of the 30 townships voted Republican for the top race on the ballot – U.S. Senate. Even when typically strong Democratic townships retained a Democratic majority, such as Bremen and Oak Park, the percentage of ballots cast often saw double digit declines.

Votes for U.S. Senate by Precinct



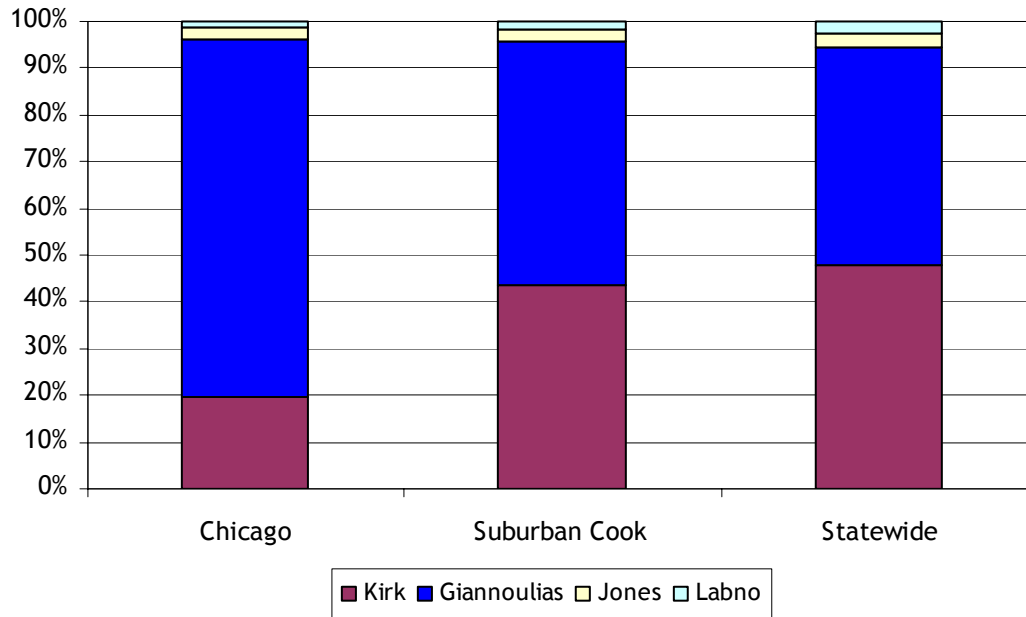

Governor's race demonstrates 'third-party' effect

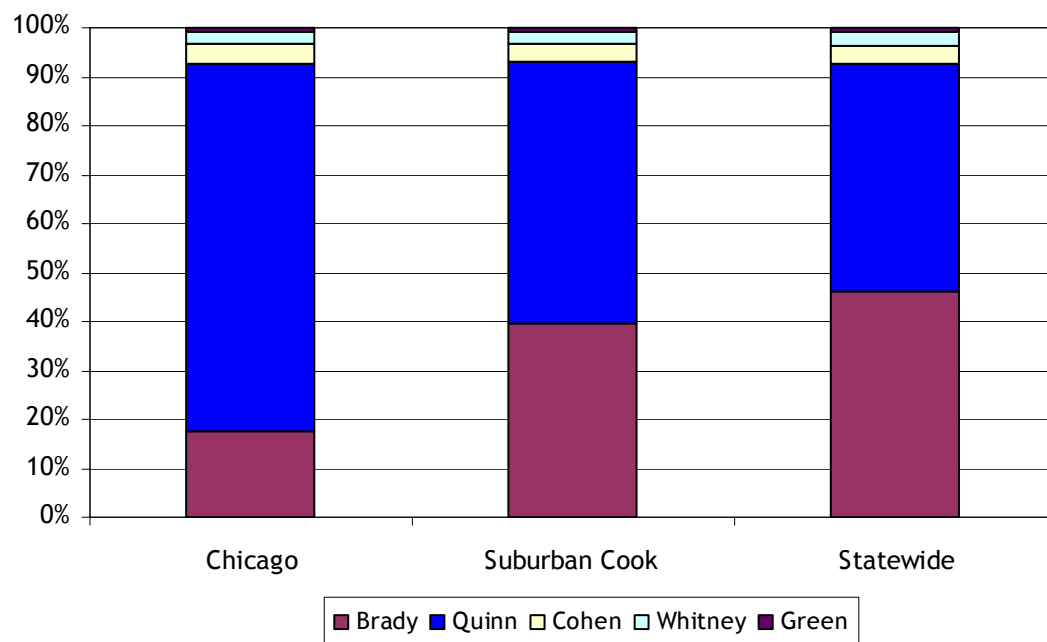
In suburban Cook County, Republican candidate for U.S. Senate Mark Kirk received 43.5 percent of the vote. However, the Republican candidate for Governor, Bill Brady did not do as well, getting 39.5 percent of the vote in suburban Cook County.

- ✓ One theory is the margin is a byproduct of the 52,496 votes (3.75 percent) that Independent Scott Lee Cohen received in Chicago and suburban Cook County.
- ✓ This argument is strengthened by a countywide trend, where Kirk received about 42,000 more votes than Brady (Kirk's 442,029 to Brady's 400,285).

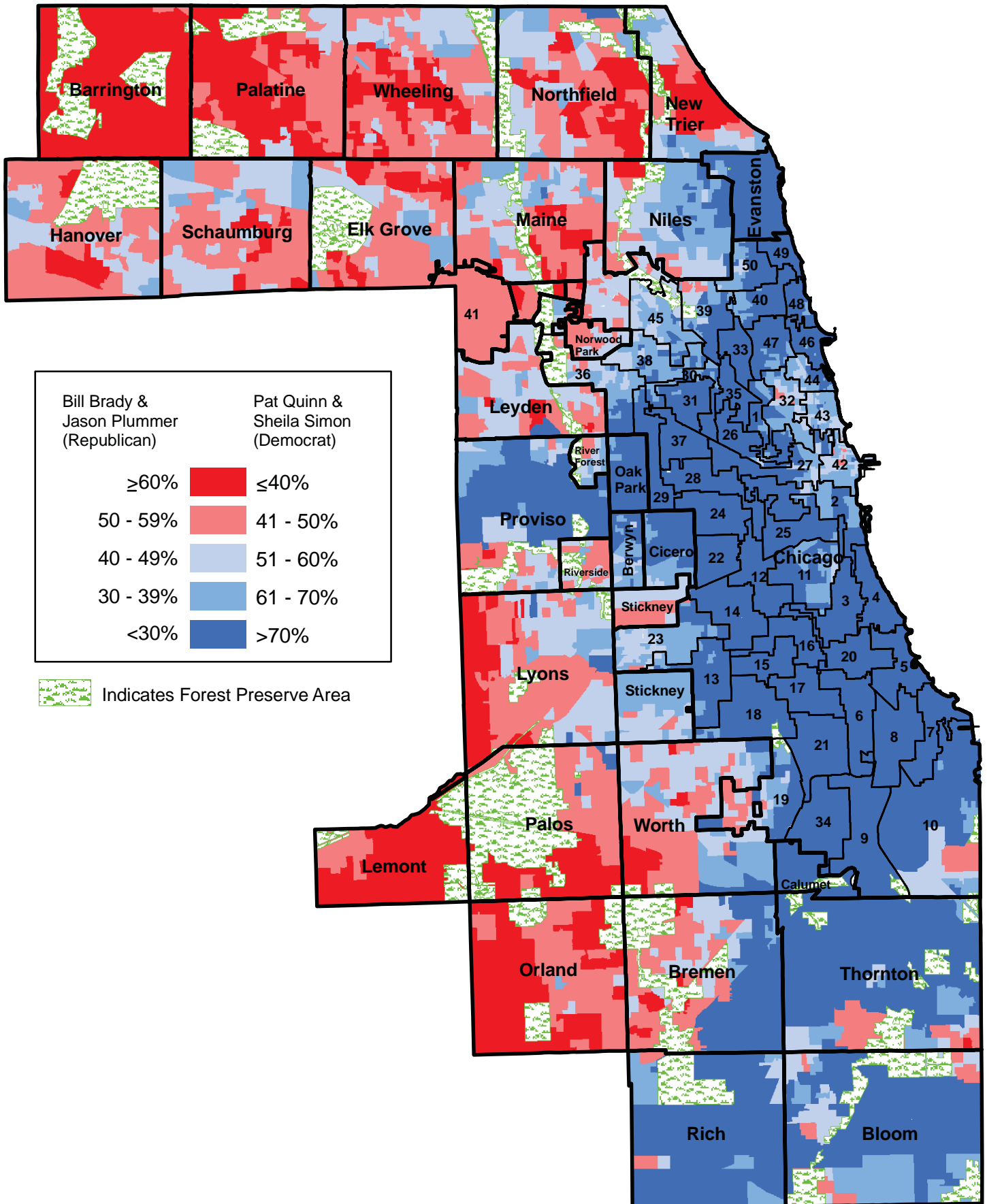
U.S. Senate Results

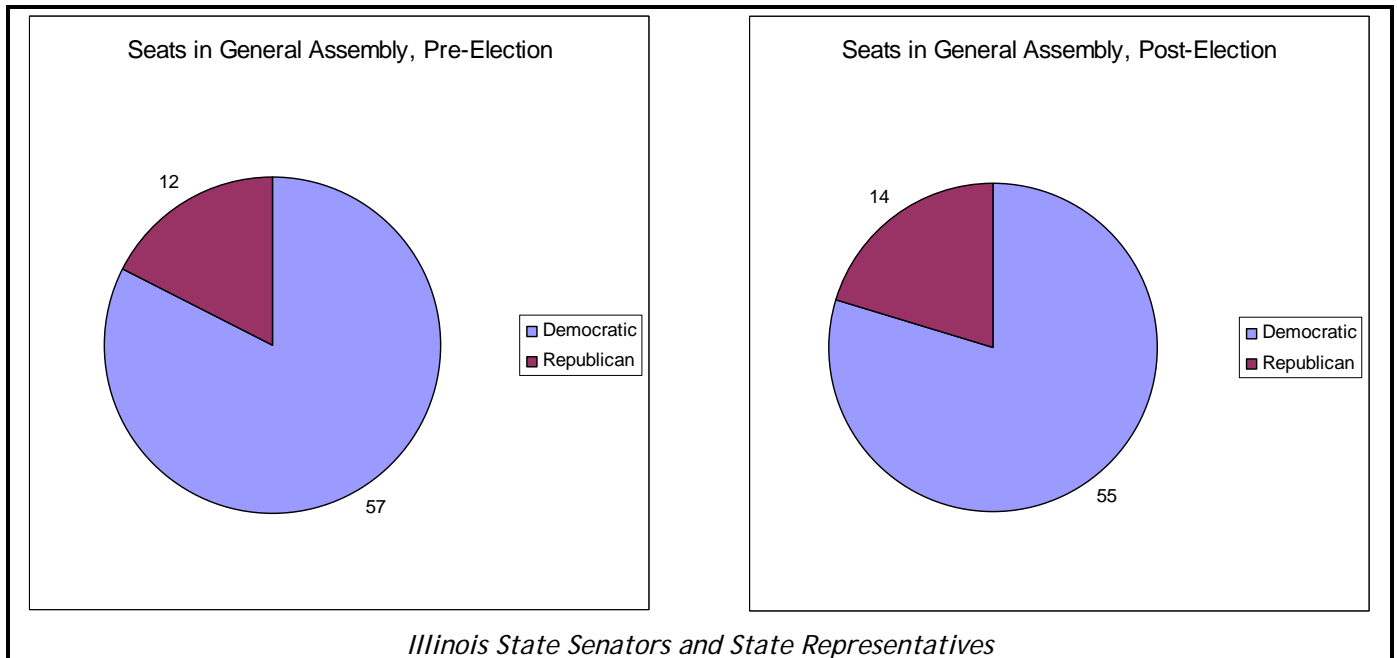
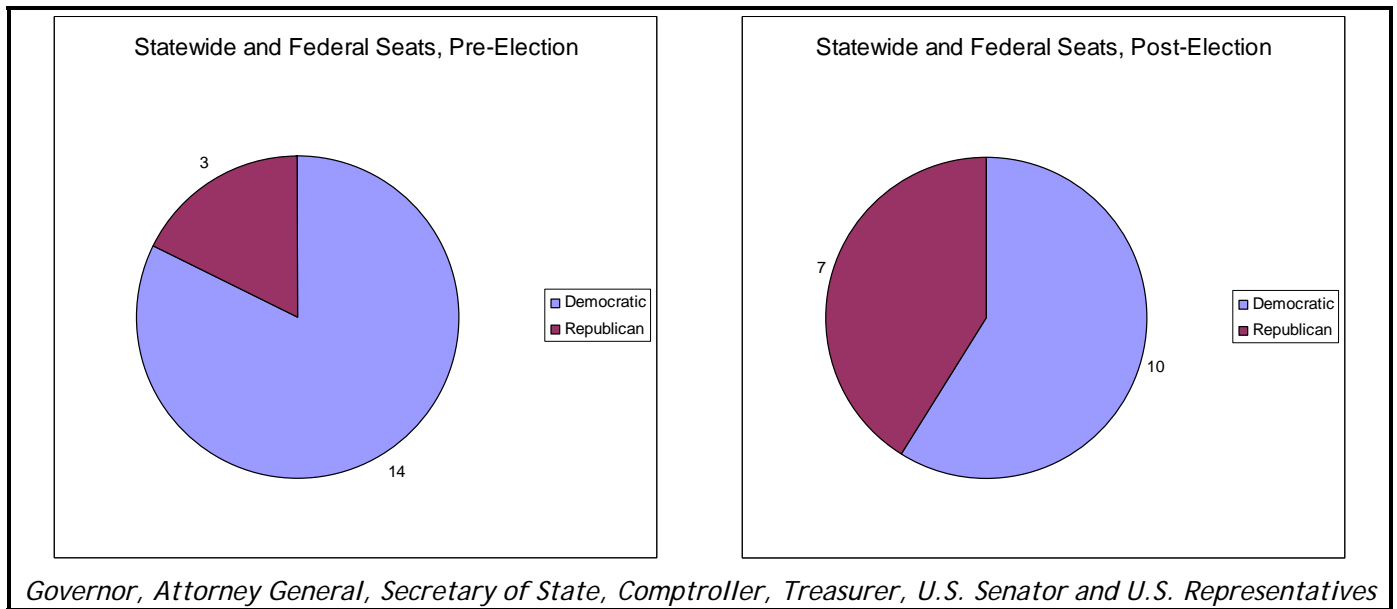
Incumbents dominate the victory column

The Nov. 2 election demonstrated the power of public office, with incumbents winning the vast majority of contests. Forty-six candidates – 43 Democrats and 3 Republicans – ran unopposed by the other major party and won; 44 of them were incumbents.

Cook County voters cast ballots in 112 federal, state and county contests:

- ✓ 41 percent of winners ran unopposed by a candidate from the other major party.
- ✓ Incumbents won 89 of the 112 seats (79%) and lost three.
- ✓ Republicans won six seats that had belonged to Democrats. Half of these were at the statewide level.
- ✓ One Republican seat on the Cook County Board—the 16th District—went Democratic.

These charts reflect only seats contested on Nov. 2, 2010 in suburban Cook County.



Party vote in top races varies by township

A look at the top of the ticket shows no suburban Cook County township chose all six statewide Republican(R) candidates, while nine cast straight Democratic(D) tickets. Only Barrington tallied up majorities for five Republicans to one Democrat (Jesse White, who was the only statewide candidate to win every township.)

However, fully half—15 townships—had a 4 to 2 ratio of R to D. Worth was the only split township, voting for three Republicans (Senate, Comptroller, Treasurer) and three Democrats (Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State). These breakdowns mirror the November 2002 election, where eight townships voted Democratic for every statewide office (the same eight as 2010, except Cicero), and Barrington voted Republican.

Hot races draw early crowds

Early Voting drew voters in some of the most hotly contested races on the ballot. **Six of the ten top Early Voting precincts were in the Dan Seals-Bruce Dold 10th Congressional District race.** A seventh precinct, Barrington 3, was in the unexpectedly tight 8th Congressional District race between Melissa Bean and Joe Walsh. Walsh defeated Bean by more than a 2 to 1 ratio in that precinct. Proviso 7 was the only precinct that had no early voters.

Just as in the 2008 presidential election, Rich Township Precinct 57 at [Marya Yates School in Matteson](#) had the greatest number of voters who cast ballots for any precinct in the November 2010 gubernatorial election. However, Rich-57 has ceded its title for the most registered voters to Hanover Township 47 - the Timber Trails School in Hoffman Estates.

Pre-Election Day voting reaches 15 percent

Nearly one in seven suburban Cook County voters voted before the Nov. 2, 2010 election. Of 111,090 voters, 86,086 voted in person at Early Voting locations (12 percent of ballots cast) and 25,004 used the new no-excuse mail-in absentee ballots, or 3.5 percent of ballots cast – a 480 percent increase compared with the 2006 election.

New Trier, Lemont, Northfield, Barrington and Calumet townships had the greatest proportion of voters vote before Nov. 2. **The townships with the highest raw numbers of pre-Election Day votes** were Northfield (7,898) Wheeling (7,492) Thornton (7,136) Orland (6,457) and New Trier (6,397). Of course, turnout doesn't always translate into big numbers in a small township. Thus, while Calumet had the fifth highest percentage of pre-Election Day voters at 20 percent, it also had the fifth **lowest pre-Election Day turnout** (1,030), just edging out Norwood Park (1,028) Riverside (666) Stickney (624) and River Forest (560).

In Suburban Cook, just 380 votes, or .0005 percent of votes cast, separated Democrat Joseph Berrios from independent Forest Claypool in a race where 682,861 ballots were cast. Claypool won more townships (16) than Berrios (9) but Berrios won them by larger margins.

- In Calumet, Berrios won 78.3 percent of the vote, in Thornton 71 percent, in Rich 64.2 percent and in Cicero 61.4 percent.
- Berrios' decisive victories played out on a larger scale in the City of Chicago where he won more than 50 percent of the vote in 32 wards. In 15 south and west side wards, Berrios' support exceeded 80 percent of the vote.
- Where Strobeck-Eckersall won, Claypool came in second in 4 of the 5 townships.
